

Installation Instructions For CC users

Method 1 – Simple Copy and Paste

Open Photoshop and go to the top menu File, then down to Scripts, then to Browse. When the pop up appears, locate the file called Extensions.jsx in the Raya Pro 3.0 download. It is in the CC Users folder. Open this.

Some folders should appear which are all Extension folders. **Close Photoshop.** You just need to copy Raya Pro into one of these extension folders to install the panel.

To do this, go into the folder called ‘CC Raya Pro 3’, select all 8 folders in there, right click and choose copy.

Then choose the Extensions folder with the most number of folders already in it. Right click in that folder and choose paste. Now 8 new folders should be in your Extensions folder.

Open Photoshop now and go to the top menu Window, and down to extensions. In there you will see Raya Pro 3 Hub. Click on this and it will open Raya Pro.

Method 2 – ZXP Installer

An alternative method is to download and install the ZXP Installer. Even if you have this already installed, please download it again and re-install it. This will make sure the ZXP Installer knows which version of PS you have installed and will fix any errors.

Note, some users might get a warning saying that this has a possible virus. This does not have a virus. It is just a small piece of software that is not well-known to antivirus software so they give this warning, just in case.

Make sure Photoshop is closed.

With the installer now installed and running, please just drag and drop the file called ‘Raya Pro 3.zxp’ into the middle of the installer. It will install automatically.

Open Photoshop now and go to the top menu Window, and down to extensions. In there you will see Raya Pro 3 Hub. Click on this and it will open Raya Pro.
